

Please find attached a few copies of a 'Look, cover, write, check' sheet, that your child may find useful when they are learning their spellings. If you would like any more copies there are more available in the classroom. Do pop in and help yourself.

Look, Cover, Write, Check is a strategy used to help children learn their spellings. Children can practise learning the spellings of words and they can test themselves independently!

Write down your spelling words in the first column. When you come to learn the words, look at each one, cover it over with a piece of paper or your hand, write the spelling again next to the word and then uncover the spelling to check if you have got it right. Repeat 2 or three more times over the week.
